**TITLE:** Beth Tzedec Congregation fonds

### **ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY:**

Beth Tzedec Congregation, sometimes referred to as Congregation Beth Tzedec, was created in 1986 and subsequently incorporated, taking on the assets and obligations of the Beth Israel and Shaarey Tzedec Congregations in what was commonly referred to as a merger or amalgamation. Such a merger had actually been discussed as early as 1958, when the Shaarey Tzedec Congregation was in its formative stages. The Beth Israel synagogue building underwent significant renovations and became the home of the new congregation. Beth Israel clergy, Rabbi Roy Tanenbaum and Cantor Morris Lang were the first spiritual leaders of Beth Tzedec congregation, whose first president was Lou Faber.

A member of The United Synagogue of America, Beth Tzedec Congregation supports many educational and religious programs for adults and children, and has an active Sisterhood that is associated with the Women's League for Conservative Judaism. Congregation events have included the Robbie Burnstein fundraising dinner, and the annual Jewish Film Festival, inaugurated in 2001.

The Beth Tzedec building is used for many community-wide events, and includes a room dedicated to honouring the history of the Beth Israel and Shaarey Tzedec congregations. Beth Tzedec Memorial Park was purchased and developed by M. Ted Riback in 1969, and gifted to Beth Israel Congregation as "Beth Israel Memorial Park" in 1976. The name was changed after the creation of Beth Tzedec Congregation.

### **SCOPE AND CONTENT:**

The fonds consists of correspondence, brochures, event programs and newsletters regarding the activities of Beth Tzedec Congregation.

The fonds has been arranged into the following series: Governance; Ritual; Memorial Park; Events; Film Festival; Newsletters.

Also included is later correspondence regarding a land swap with a real estate developer.

The series has been maintained as received, in the following subseries: Preliminaries & Updates (including land swap); Governance; Landscaping, Sign, Opening & Renaming Events; Memorial Park Board Meetings; "Merger".
