ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY:

Emuna was a sorority for Jewish girls, aged 12 through high school, that existed during the late 1930s to late 1940s. They usually met at family homes, and while mothers helped out when needed, there was no formal adult supervision or advisor. Emuna organized dances, sometimes with a fraternity called Kadima, and raised money for Youth Aliyah. The executive in 1946-1947 included Jenny Lavin (President), Reva Sheinin (Vice-President), Fran Libin (Treasurer), Bertha Chester (Secretary) and Doreen Levitt (Keeper of the Log).
