SCOPE AND CONTENT:

The sub-sub-series consists of a circumcision kit used by Rabbi Simon Smolensky, as well as a copy of a girl's naming certificate, and invitations to an *upsherenish* [boy's first hair cut] and a girl's first Sabbath candle-lighting, both of which happen at the age of three. The circumcision kit includes a box of cotton gauze, scalpels and case, honing stone, shield, antiseptic ointment, tannic acid powder, and two adrenalin vials. These materials were originally received in a disintegrating leather medical bag, which was discarded by the archives.

SCOPE AND CONTENT:

The sub-series consists of items used during the daily practice of Judaism. It includes a *mizrach* [plaque or other hanging that indicates an east-facing wall], a Book of Psalms and a set of *shechita* (kosher slaughter) knives.

SCOPE AND CONTENT:

The series consists of objects that have no religious dictate, but are associated primarily with the cultural practice of Judaism as expressed by individuals. These objects include a bagel platter, *hackmesser* (chopping knife), decorative plaque with psalm, electric menorah, brass "ten commandments" business card holder, "ten commandments" book ends, and a copy of "*Lieder des Ghetto*" by Morris Rosenfeld. Also included is a 1948 "Cook Book" published by the Moose Jaw, Saskatchewan, Lillian Freiman Chapter of Hadassah, and a "cupping" set (7 glass 'cups', 6 matching, one presumed to be non-original; bottle with trace of antiseptic; brush; thermometer; needle (BD-25) stuck in a cork; 8x8x5cm wooden block holding a cotton ball on the end of a wire) used for therapeutic purposes.
