ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY:

Calgary BBYO (originally called B'nai B'rith Youth Organization) began in 1926 with the establishment of an Aleph Zadik Aleph (AZA) chapter called International #31. AZA, a social and community service group for Jewish teenage boys, had been founded in Nebraska in 1923, and was adopted by the men's fraternal organization B'nai Brith as its official youth program in 1925. Calgary International AZA #31 was the first chapter established outside the United States. BBYO was created in 1944 when B'nai Brith officially recognized B'nai Brith Girls (BBG), a social and community service group for Jewish teenage girls that had been in existence since 1927. The first Calgary BBG chapter, Daughters of the Star (D.O.T.S.) was established in 1947. At its peak, Calgary BBYO had 2 AZA chapters and 3 BBG chapters.

Calgary BBYO is part of Northwest Canada Region #87 (formerly District Six) of BBYO International. Following the model of its international body, Calgary BBYO was established as a pluralistic Jewish youth movement and has offered programming within distinct areas such as leadership training, social action and Jewish education. In addition to its local programs, Calgary BBYO has been an active participant in Regional activities, hosting and attending conferences and conventions throughout Alberta and Saskatchewan. Local members have also participated and served on the District level, and participated in International events. In 2002, BBYO became a legally separate entity from B'nai B'rith.

SCOPE AND CONTENT:

The fonds consists of minutes, newsletters, membership lists, reports and convention information regarding Calgary BBYO, as well as material produced by BBYO International.

The series consists of minutes, correspondence, newsletters, a membership ledger, event scripts and programs, blank stationery, a local history booklet, member pins and a trophy. The series has been arranged into the following sub-series: International #31, Stampede #1046.

The series consists of chapter reports, a 1976 autograph book and key tag, and an event notice and program, as well as Regional BBG newsletters, a 1967 Northwest Canada BBG yearbook, an award presentation speech, a Member-In-Training (M.I.T.) welcome letter, an induction speech, a script for the 1962 Installation luncheon, and a "A Golden Sisterhood" pin.
