ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY:

Jewish Family Service Calgary was established in 1960 as the Calgary Jewish Family Service Bureau (JFSB), through the combined efforts of The Canadian Jewish Federation of Welfare Funds, the Calgary Joint Jewish Administrative Office (JJAO), Calgary B'nai Brith, National Council of Jewish Women (NCJW), and the Jewish Relief Society, to provide counselling and financial assistance to Calgary's Jewish community. JFSB began operating out of the JJAO in the House of Israel community building, with Martha Cohen as volunteer executive director / counsellor, and NCJW donated money to go toward the hiring of a part-time social worker. JFSB became one of the first member agencies of Calgary's United Jewish Appeal in 1963, and Sabine Joffe, who held a Master of Social Work degree, was hired in 1966 as full-time Executive Director.

The organization has been variously known as Jewish Family Service Bureau, Jewish Family Service (Calgary), and Jewish Family Service Calgary, providing counselling, employment and various family-life services, in many languages.

The fonds consists of correspondence, programs, reports (including Annual Reports) and newsletters from Jewish Family Service Calgary.
