ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY:

Jewish National Fund (JNF) Calgary is part of JNF Canada, which itself is an arm of JNF-KKL (Jewish National Fund-*Keren Kayemet Le Yisrael*), a non-profit organization founded in 1901 to buy and develop land in what was then Ottoman Palestine (subsequently Israel) for Jewish settlement. Over the years JNF has placed much emphasis on irrigation, environmental and reclamation projects, as well as immigrant settlement programs.

One of JNF's earliest, and longest-lasting fund-raising initiatives is the distribution of "Blue Boxes", small tin boxes with a slot in the top, used primarily within Jewish homes to collect coins that are then donated to JNF. Funds are also raised through the sale of trees (to be planted in Israel), the issue of stamps "of historical and philatelic interest", and the sale of Golden Book and other commemorative certificates -- issued by JNF to acknowledge donations made to JNF, generally in honour of an individual's or organization's activities, or personal milestones -- as well as large-scale annual and oneoff events. A major fund-raising project for JNF Canada has been the Negev Dinner, held annually in many Jewish communities, including Calgary.

JNF activities in Calgary were initially overseen by the Winnipeg office, and the first Calgary JNF office was opened in 1976, with Micha Peled as Executive Director. Calgary's inaugural Negev Diner was held in 1955, honouring community pioneer Charles Waterman. Subsequent "Negev" events, while not necessarily annual, have included concerts and "Galas", as well as dinners. Other fundraising activities have included speakers, concerts and sports events.

SCOPE AND CONTENT:

The fonds consists of correspondence, Golden Book and other commemorative certificates, fundraising items, and program and publicity material from JNF Calgary / JNF Canada /JNF-KKL.

The fonds has been arranged into the following series: Correspondence, Certificates, Activities, Negev Dinner, JNF-KKL.

SCOPE AND CONTENT:

The series consists of two framed JNF Golden Book certificates ("for Jacob Diamond … President of the Congregation House of Jacob, by the Agudath Zion of Calgary" 1913; by "Calgary B'nai Brith Lodge in the name of H. Chrystal, President" 1942); a 1958 certificate from the "Children's Register of the Keren Kayemeth LeIsrael", acknowledging the birth of Jeffrey Stephen Kerr, inscribed by his grandparents, Alex and Gertie Belkin; a "Citation of Honour" from JNF to Edythe Pearlman (1976); and a 1994 JNF acknowledgement of a significant donation from Bnai Brith Calgary toward a project in Israel.
