ADMINISTRATIVE HISTORY:

B'nai Brith Calgary Lodge #816 (spelled B'nai B'rith until 1989), commonly referred to as B'nai Brith (BB), received its charter on June 17, 1917, with Benjamin Ginsberg serving as president. It was part of North West Canadian Council (NWCC), District 6, of the Jewish service organization B'nai Brith Canada, which is in turn part of B'nai B'rith International. NWCC and the lodges of Eastern Canada of B'nai Brith amalgamated in 1981 to form Canadian B'nai Brith District 22. The organization's primary focus has always been to strengthen and support the Jewish community, and to combat antisemitism, bigotry and racism.

Since the beginning, B'nai Brith Calgary activities have promoted social engagement as well as social action. Members have regularly participated in curling and other sporting events, attended dinners and musical revues, listened to speakers, and raised funds for the Lodge's many community-assistance programs. These have ranged from helping to furnish and equip military base lounges during WWII and providing a work-placement service for European refugees through the 1950s, to the establishment of many programs and activities for local Jewish youth, including B'nai Brith Young Men, the B'nai Brith Youth Organization and Hillel. In 1956, in cooperation with the B'nai Brith Lodge #732 in Edmonton, B'nai Brith Calgary opened Camp B'nai Brith (later renamed Camp B.B.-Riback) in central Alberta, and for many years was one of its main supporters. Over the years, the Calgary lodge has published different iterations of a newsletter, including "B.B. Topics" and "Menorah".

Funds have been raised through a range of activities including concerts and charity auctions, tennis tournaments and the organization's longest-running and most successful event, the B'nai Brith Gentlemen's Dinner. Originally simply called The Stag, this annual event has raised millions of dollars for local charities since its inception in 1950. Most of the funds raised are returned to the Jewish and general communities in the form of grants to other organizations who offer children's or seniors programming, serve the disadvantaged, ill or vulnerable, or work to sustain culture and identity. The organization also monitors and speaks out against antisemitic and other racist activity, and has often worked in collaboration with other community groups.

In 1987 there was a move to organize a second B'nai Brith chapter in Calgary, #3323.

SCOPE AND CONTENT:

The fonds consists of minutes, correspondence, programming material, event programs and memorabilia, handbills, a banner, certificates, songbooks, curling sweater crests, and curling bonspiel objects including badges, pins and a trophy.

Included in this series is a 1944 list of Western Canada Council Representatives and Officers, a 1952 Northwest Convention booklet, and a large (73cm x 93cm) illuminated list of WWII veterans, "... members of B'Nai B'Rith Calgary Lodge No 816 and the Jewish community of Calgary". Also included is a 'Gold Menorah Member' card, and 4 different membership pins.

The program from the 60th Annual Gentlemen's Dinner was signed by honouree, Ed Stelmach; the program from the 1949 event was signed by guest speaker, Eleanor Roosevelt. Also included is a booklet from the B'nai B'rith and AZA 1938 Second Annual Conference of the Western Canadian Council, and one from the Northwest Canada Council of B'nai Brith Lodges First Annual Convention, May 1948.
